We are very proud of the education programs and learning opportunities and activities that are on offer at Reservoir Views Primary School. We are focussed on providing your children with a comprehensive, fully resourced and up to date education in a clean and safe environment. We are also providing rewarding educational experiences in programs such as Camps, Sport, Excursion and Incursions, which also become great memories for your children to fondly look back on.

In 2021, we are thrilled to advise that we will be offering a Classroom Music specialist program in addition to our PE, visual art and LOTE (Italian) specialist programs. We welcome support from our parent community by way of a voluntary contribution to help purchase vital equipment and resources to assist in establishing this program.

Reservoir Views Primary School makes every effort to keep the cost of items and activities to a minimum and affordable for all parents. School Council has recently completed it's annual review of the Parent Payment Policy and Parent Payment Charges for 2021.

Financial Support for Families

Reservoir Views Primary School understands that some families may experience financial difficulty and offers a range of support options, including:

- the Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund (CSEF) provides payments for eligible students to contribute to the cost of camps, sports and excursions (\$125 per eligible student)
- Centrepay instalments available for families who receive Centrelink benefits
- Payment plans
- · State Schools Relief

Payment Methods

Payments can be made by Qkr, EFTPOS in the office (Visa and Mastercard accepted), or cash directly to the office. Centrelink (Centrepay) is available for those who receive a Centrelink benefit. A portion of your fortnightly payment can be sent directly to the school to offset any Parent Payments owing. See attached information for more details.

We would appreciate payment by *Friday 11th December 2020* to enable us to have classroom supplies ready to start the school year, however payment is not required until 28th January 2021.

Refunds

School Council has the responsibility to ensure there is a fair and equitable refund system in place following payment for Camps/Excursions/Incursions and Essential Education item and to ensure parent provide information to the school in a timely manner for planning purposes. The following is a summary of the main principles of the Parent Payments Policy:



FREE INSTRUCTION

 Schools provide students with free instruction to fulfil the standard curriculum requirements as outlined in the Victorian Curriculum F-10, VCE and VCAL.

PARENT PAYMENT REQUESTS

- Schools do not ask parents to pay for school operating costs (e.g. utility costs) or general and unspecified charges.
- Schools request payments from parents under three categories:

- Items and activities which the school deems essential for student learning.
- Parents may choose to purchase essential items through the school or provide their own.

Optional Items

- Items and activities
 that enhance or
 broaden the

- These are provided to students on a user-pays basis.

Voluntary Contributions

- Voluntary contributions support the school to continue to be the best local school for all students and can be for general or specific purpose.

CENTRELINK - CENTREPAY

For families who receive regular Centrelink payments

What is Centrepay?

Centrepay is a free direct bill-paying service offered to customers receiving Centrelink payments. Through Centrepay you can choose to pay school fees, excursions, camps etc by having a regular amount deducted from your payments and transferred electronically to Reservoir Views Primary School.

Will it cost you anything?

There is no charge for this service.

Is there a minimum payment amount?

Yes, the minimum payment is \$10 / fortnight

How do you apply for Centrepay?

Step 1: sign in and access the main menu. Sign into myGov and select your **Centrelink** online account to access the main menu and your homepage. ...

Step 3: choose a service provider. ...Reservoir Views Primary School CRN: 555 125 684 T

Step 2: add a new **Centrepay deduction**. ...

Step 4: enter the details of your **deduction**. ...

Step 5: review and submit. ...

Step 6: sign out.

Can you change your Centrepay deductions?

Yes, you can change, suspend or cancel your deductions at any time online at **humanservices.gov.au/onlineservices**

What changes can you make to your Centrepay deductions?

You can make the following changes to your deductions:

- suspend your deduction amount temporarily for a maximum period of 13 weeks
- request a future end date when deductions will automatically cease
- nominate or change a target amount so deductions will automatically stop when that target amount has been reached
- change the deduction amount you are paying to a new amount or change the amount temporarily
- cancel your deduction at any time.
